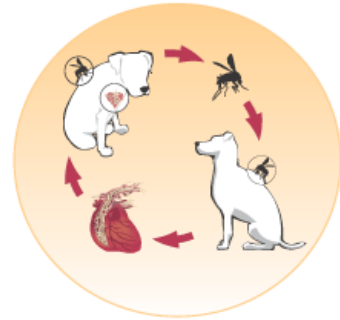
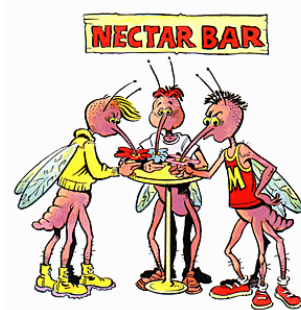
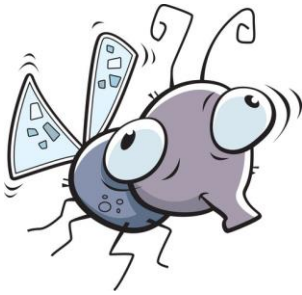


May means mosquitoes, and mosquitoes bring heartworm



It is May and Spring is in the air, unfortunately, so are a lot of things, like mosquitoes. It only takes ONE to infect your beloved pet with heartworm. Mosquitoes don't pick just one host, they are moving—from one to the next to the next and possibly onto your very own pet. Without annual testing, there is no way to know if your pet is free from heartworm.

The scariest and most dangerous thing about heartworm is that there are no symptoms until your pet's well on its way to having heartworm disease. Unlike intestinal parasites (ie roundworms, hookworms) that can be treated with one dose now and another in 10-14 days, heartworms invade through the blood stream (through a bite) travel to the heart and make their homes. It takes up to 6 months for the heartworm larvae to mature into adults and those adults can live from 5 to 7 YEARS!!

So, pet lovers... have your pets tested annually, and make sure you are giving them their appropriate preventative—let's all be especially conscious of this potentially devastating disease. Let's keep ALL hearts healthy!!
